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## Call for Applications for various Awards to be given in 2017

The General Secretary, Indian Mathematical Society (IMS), invites applications from the researchers working in Mathematics for the following awards to be given by the IMS in 2017.

The applications, along with the soft copies of the published papers and the documents indicating the proof of birth date / age should be sent to Prof. N. K. Thakare, General Secretary, IMS, by e-mail on the e-mail address

so as to reach him on or before June 30, 2017. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

The author/s can apply for only one award and he / she should not submit more than one publication for the corresponding award. The papers considered must have been published either online or in print version in 2016.

### 1. Name of the Award :

**A. K. Agarwal Award for 2016 for Best publication in any journal.**

**Areas:** Number theory, Combinatorics, Discrete mathematics, Analysis, Algebra.

**Nature of the Award:** Citation and a cash prize of Rs.10,000 /-(Rs.Ten thousand).

### Terms and Conditions:

(i) The paper should be in single authorship. In exceptional cases, the paper by two authors could be considered. In this event the prize amount will be equally divided.

(ii) The upper age limit is 45 years on 31 st December 2017 and in case of two authors both must be below 45 years.

(iii) The author/s should be Indian citizen/s and must have carried out the said research work in India.

**2. Name of the Award :****A. M. Mathai Award for 2016 for Best Publication in Applicable Mathematics.**

**Areas:** Any branch of mathematics which has some applications in other fields such as Physical Sciences, Biological and Medical Sciences, Social Sciences, Probability and Statistics.

**Nature of the Award:** Citation and a cash prize of Rs.30,000 /-(Rs.Thirty thousand).

**Terms and Conditions:**

- (i) The paper should be in single authorship.
- (ii) The upper age limit is 35 years as on 31 st December 2017 and the person need not be an Indian citizen.
- (iii) The author should be associated with any university / college / institution in India where the work was done and the paper mentions the name of that institution as affiliation.

**3. Name of the Award:****Satish Bhatnagar Award for 2016 for best Publication in History of Mathematics in India.**

**Area:** The paper should be in the area of History of Mathematics focusing on a person, problem, reign, or system of education or government.

**Nature of the Award:** Citation and a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand).

**Terms and Conditions:**

- (i) The paper should be in single authorship.
- (ii) The author should be above 35 years of age on 31st December 2017 and the person need not be an Indian citizen.
- (iii) Anyone who has a masters degree in mathematical sciences and Ph. D. in any other area (including history, political science, Sanskrit, archaeology, Indology etc.) is eligible to submit the paper.
